INTRODUCTION

The Library and Resource Centre (LRC) was set up in 1993, to facilitate systematic storage and dissemination of information related to fashion, textile and apparel industry. Over the years, the LRC has grown from strength to strength, and is today considered to be one of the leading content providers of fashion related information. All LRC services are now available across the four campuses in India at New Delhi, Jaipur, Noida & Mumbai.

The Library has a comprehensive collection of print and non-print materials on fashion related disciplines, including an impressive collection of audio visual resources.

The Resource Centre has an extensive collection of materials relating to study of textiles, ranging from fibers, yarns, fabric samples, accessories, designer's collections, forecast magazines and Pantone textile color specifier among others. The Resource Centre acts as a catalyst and support the faculty, students and the textile industry by showcasing the latest trends in the fashion industry and by providing information and directory services.

SERVICES OFFERED

The Library holds a comprehensive and up-to-date collection of knowledge resources, both print and non-print resources, on fashion and related disciplines. It is organized as per international standards and is fully automated. A growing collection of carefully selected books, both Indian and international, all relating to the curriculum of the Academy are available in the library. This collection gets continuously updated by the addition of new books. The collection includes many standard reference books as well.

The library subscribes to a wide range of periodicals, mostly international, which present the latest in the fashion industry around the world. This includes leading trend services on fashion, textiles and home fashion. Bound volumes of many of these are also available. The library subscribes to leading online databases - ProQuest ABI Complete, EBSCO (Art & Architecture & Communication & Mass Media Complete), allowing access to many e-journals.

Borrowing Facility

Associate Members are eligible to borrow 2 books and 2 bound volumes of periodicals at any given time, for a period of seven days. It is important to ensure that the issued items are returned on or before the due date. An overdue charge @ Rs. 5 days per book/periodical/bound volumes will be levied on late return for the first 7 calendar days and @ Rs. 10 per calendar day thereafter.

Reference Service

Professional staff is available to assist users to locate the required resource or information.

Bibliographic Services

Bibliographies of books and other resources can be provided on demand.

Current Awareness Service

Forthcoming trade events notifications are displayed in the library and also posted on the intranet.

Press Clipping Services

News clippings related to fashion industry are regularly circulated through intranet and back files of these are maintained and available online.

Reprographic Service

Selective reprographic service is provided to users. Users can also make use of the scanning facility provided in the library.

Trend Publications

Library subscribes to leading trend services on fashion, textiles and home fashion.

Periodicals

Library subscribes to about 100 periodicals, both Indian and International, on various subjects. These are available for reference. Bound volumes of periodicals are available for borrowing.

Color Services

Pantone Textile Color Specifier (paper edition) chips are available for purchase.

Pantone Textile Cotton Specifier (cotton edition) available for reference.

Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC)

The catalogues of books, reports, DVDs/CDs, and periodical articles are available online for the users.

Care of LRC resources

Any member causing damage to the books, periodicals or any other material in the LRC, while consulting within the Academy premises or

during the period on loan to them, will be solely responsible for compensation of the damages as per rules.

Loss of Book etc

In case of loss of any material borrowed from the library, the member should either replace the same or pay three times the cost of the material along with overdue charges, within 90 days.

For using the Library and Resource Centre, members are required to present their Identity Cards at the Circulation desk.
